Summary:-

- ♣ 29 boxes were checked.
- ♣ Of these, 18 (62.0%) had firm evidence of a nest present and used.
- ♣ A further four ((13.8%) had material present but the nest had not been completed.
- ♣ A couple of the open fronted (robin) boxes have been used, but the removal of shielding ivy may have contributed to under occupancy.

Further Comments:-

- The numbering on most of the initial tranche has faded, and needs to be renewed.
- ♣ The map needs updating with 2012 and 2013 sites added.
- ♣ Several locations for additional boxes have been identified.

Summary of Boxes Installed 21st. February 2013.

- ♣ 2 open fronted 8cm aperture
- ♣ 3 with 35mm aperture
- 9 with 30mm aperture
- ♣ 1 RSPB box (2012 tranche) repaired and reinstated.
- "lifting lid" boxes secured against squirrel access.
