## **Barnfield Sandbeds Nest Box Survey November 2019**

## 1) General

Survey carried out November 1<sup>st</sup>. 7<sup>th</sup>. and 21<sup>st</sup> 2019. Thanks to Mike Woodall (days 1 and 2), Glen Sibley (days 1 and 3) and Bob Short (days 1,2 and 3) for their help.

## 2) Summary

- ➤ 61 boxes were checked (including two recovered and opened off site).
- 41 had full nests.
- Occupancy rate was 67.2% (in 2018 the rate was 72%).
- Several boxes (including three previously accessed from Sands Field) were not checked due to difficult / dangerous access.
- ➤ A large number of tree tags were obscured due to growth of tree trunks learning point here is to leave space between the tag and the tree itself.
- ➤ As in previous years we were unable to find some boxes as indicated by gaps in the numerical sequence.
- Four damaged boxes and one box lost due to tree felling were replaced.
- New hay was placed in all boxes.
- One recovered box can be repaired.
- One area south west of the pond has capacity for additional boxes.
- On some sites the telescopic ladder needs to be secured by a rope or strap for additional stability.
