Kidsgrove Area

From Stoke make your way via Tunstall, Goldenhill, down Kidsgrove bank, at the second set of traffic lights turn right into Heath Cote Street.

Free Parking on the left hand side, but no toilet facilities open on a Sunday.

Map Ref:- OS Landranger 118 – 831 545.

Time: 9.45 for a 10.00 start.

The walk is approx 6 miles long.

When trying to connect Kidsgrove through the Potteries, the early canal builders and railway engineers found a sizeable hill stretching from Red Street across to Newchapel. The result was three parallel tunnels over 1½ miles long, two for canals on one for the railway. This walk visits both the north and south portals of the canal tunnels and takes in the beautiful Bathpool Park where the waters of the reservoir feed the Trent and Mersey Canal in the tunnel below. Some road walking, and gentle countryside.

Please bring your own food and drink, for the morning break & lunch stop.
