

Moorside Walking Club

Bickerton Hills September 9th 2018

Meet for a 10:00 AM departure at the Bickerton Hills National Trust Car Park (free but no facilities).

Map Ref 353531 Explorer Map 257

Nearest Sat Nav SY14 8LN + 1/2 mile further on.

From Stoke take the A500 to Nantwich, following the signs around Nantwich ring road (A51) for the A534 and Wrexham.

Cross the A49 (turning right then left).

Turn left after about 3 miles signposted Bickerton, Egerton Green and Cholmondeley. (0.7 miles after the Bickerton Poacher Inn)

Cross a minor crossroads into Goldford Lane and the car park driveway is 0.5 miles on the right at the side of a pond. The driveway is unmade and rather bumpy!



The walk is about 7 miles long partly following the Sandstone Trail to take in the South and then the North escarpments of the Bickerton Hills visiting the iron age fort Maiden Castle, Mad Allens Hole and Raw Head.

Pretty low level scenery and spectacular views from the tops with a little road walking along quiet lanes to link up the two escarpments.
