| Distance | 7.7 miles |
| Start Time | 09:45 for 10:00 start |
| Starting Point | Ticknall Village Hall Ingleby Lane Ticknall DE73 7JX |
| Directions | These are the directions from Blythe Bridge, but I'm assuming everyone will be using the A50, so please adjust accordingly. After approximately 30 miles take the exit for Swadlincote (A514). At the roundabout turn right towards Swadlincote. After crossing a long fairly narrow bridge, you will enter the village of Stanton by Bridge. Shortly after leaving Stanton by Bridge turn right, again towards Swadlincote. After passing Calke Abbey turn right opposite the Wheel Inn into Ingleby Drive. The village hall car park is on the left. |
| Travel Time | Approximately 45 mins from Blythe Bridge |
| Description | A fairly flat walk largely on paths, however there are a few road stretches and fields, so please be prepared for the odd muddy bit depending how the weather has been closer to the walk date. |
| Lunch | There is a little café at the reservoir near our morning coffee stop, if anyone wishes to indulge. Otherwise please bring your usual refreshments and lunch. |
| Toilets | There are toilets available at the village hall and also at the coffee stop at Foremark Reservoir. |
| Route | Ticknall - Foremark Reservoir – Carver's Rocks Nature Reserve – Smith's Gorse – Tramway tunnel – Lime kilns |
