Cromford Heights Walk

- Map:** Explorer OL24 – The Peak District (White Peak Area)
- Grade:** Moderate
- The Route:** Steeple Grange – High Peak Trail - Cromford Canal – Cromford Village – Harp Edge – Bonsall – Via Gellia Mill – Groaning Tor – Middleton Village – Middleton Moor - High Peak Trail – Steeple Grange
- Terrain:** The walk will involve descending inclines of the former Cromford and High Peak Railway, some canal walking, a few moderately steep climbs, some flatter sections and small amount of road walking. There could be some muddy sections after prolonged or heavy rain.
- Distance:** Approximately 8.5 miles
- Parking:** On road parking by terminus of the Steeple Grange light railway.
(Car sharing would be helpful if possible)
Post Code DE4 4LS
- Toilets:** Black Rocks, High Peak Junction, Cromford Wharf, Bonsall and Middleton Top
- Time:** 09.45 for 10.00 am start
- Directions:** Take your preferred route to Ashbourne. From Ashbourne take the B5035 (Wirksworth) and in approximately 8.7 miles at Rise End traffic lights continue ahead. In a short distance after passing the entrance to the National Stone Centre/Eco Centre (right) take the next right into an unnamed lane.
