

The Edges from Birchen Edge Car Park

Starting Point - Birchen Edge Car Park, next to The Robin Hood Pub. This is a free car park and gets busy so try to be early.
No toilets.

Map O.S Leisure 24 White Peak - grid ref. 281721

Travel time from Stoke approx. 1hr 20mins

Meet time - 0945 for 1000 start.

Distance - 9.5 miles (or alan's 10!!)

Lunch & breaks - please bring your own food.

Travel Directions - Head towards Bakewell and after passing through Bakewell take the A619 Chesterfield Rd towards Baslow. After passing through Baslow you will reach a large roundabout, and the A619 continues right. Follow A619 for 1 mile and just after sharp bends turn left onto minor road B6050. The Robin Hood Pub is on the left and the car park is next to it.

Walk Details - We start with a short sharp ascent onto birchen edge, passing the Nelson Monument, and over open moorland to White Edge, the highest point of the walk with excellent views down the Hope valley. Our return is via Froggatt Edge, Curber and Baslow Edges and finishes with a climb up to Gardom's Edge.

A very scenic walk throughout, weather permitting.

Walking conditions not too difficult, only 2 stiles, and mainly flat walking along the edges.
